FAQ'S - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is decor styling?

Decor styling is the much like that of an interior designer OR a fashion designer, only that we design the creative and logistical implementation of your venue space. From Lighting, to stationery, decor to floral; to overall creative elements required to develop a space fit for a functional event. Styling ensures one uniform approach, with one person tackling the creative and one vision coming to life.

Does the styling fee include our decor and floral?

No, this is to cover the services rendered to get to the desired end goal of the full design of the event space as specified in the package breakdown. It covers travel for meetings, meeting times, floral, decor and all elements of table design for your mock up, inclusive of hours on the day of the wedding/event for a stylist to be present and manage the set-up and strike of all suppliers.

What is the average decor/floral creative budget?

This is a very difficult question, as there are so many factors that play a role to either raise budgets OR make them cheaper ie. Less people = cheaper wedding; Venue that is not a shell, has less elements required to be hired in, so we simply need to work with the space we have and style according to the logistical brief = Cheaper. ...so we there rather give a guideline. Entry level décor budgets are between R30 – R50k, average overall budgets can range between R60k - R80k, with more luxurious items being between the R80k - R120k margin. Please note however, that formal quotes will be given to clients based on their budget set aside, and also tailored to their respective needs.

When do you leave the wedding/event?

As soon as the entire event/wedding space is set up. We deliver the bouquets directly to the client where they are getting ready; after which we then leave. Essentially once the creative elements of the wedding are set in place, the logistical coordinator OR Venue coordinator then takes over and runs the early evening to late evening proceedings.

If I need further assistance with on the day coordination OR planning can you assist?

Indeed we can. We work hand in hand with a set coordinator who's passion and forte` is to manage and run the logistics of your event.
